The Financial Aid & Scholarships Office delivers more than \$128 million in financial aid awards to qualified students at the Denver Campus each year. Graduate Students will be considered for a financial aid award primarily made up of student loans. Some work-study funding is available to graduate students as well.

To be considered for financial aid, students should complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA (<https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa/>)) annually. The application becomes available October 1 of each year for the upcoming year's funding. Upon completing the application, students should monitor their email provided on the FAFSA, University email, and UCDAccess (<https://passport.ucdenver.edu/login.php>) portal To Do List for requests for follow up paperwork.
